Three-peat! Napa wins “County of the Year” award again

For the third consecutive year, Napa County Farm Bureau was honored to be named County of the Year in its membership category in recognition of an outstanding program of work at the grassroots level. CFBF President Paul Wenger presented the award to Napa Farm Bureau President Dana Estensen and Executive Director Sandy Elles during the awards banquet at the California Farm Bureau Federation Annual Meeting in Sparks, Nevada, on December 5th with over 1,000 Farm Bureau members and supporters in attendance.

In receiving the award, NCFB President Dana Estensen said, “The County of the Year award is a tribute to our Board of Directors, volunteers and staff who work on a daily basis to promote and protect Napa County agriculture. We are humbled by the honor and grateful for the support of our community.”

Statewide judges scored the counties in five categories – Policy Implementation, Leadership Development, Ag Education/Promotion, Member Services and Public Relations. Napa also won the President’s Program of the Year award in three of the five categories.
